If we decide to proceed, we will be setting up a work party to cut the trees and brush in the project area only, likely to be a Saturday in January, weather permitting (most winter days are good enough for this type of work, but we would likely not work in a high wind or in weather so cold as to keep us in the clubhouse most of the time).

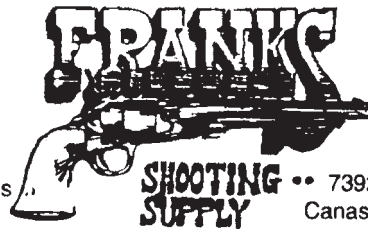
